Description of host: the Biblioteca di Scienze dell'Antichità e Filologia moderna is located near the centre of the city of Milan, on the main Campus of the University of Milan.

It is a library dedicated to the collection of books, journals and archival materials regarding the study of antiquities (archaeology, ancient history, Latin and Greek literature and philology, glottology), alongside the study of Italian literature and language. The library has a collection of more than 2.400 books ca. of modern Greek literature, in Greek and in other languages.

The library is widely used by students and faculties and offers a variety of services. It cooperates closely with the Department of Literary Studies, Philology and Linguistics. Eight librarians work regularly at the library, taking care of all the tasks a modern academic library needs.

In the last 8 years, the library has hosted several internship students, who helped the staff with specific projects.

Description of project: in the past, the books written in the Greek alphabet, owned by the library, were catalogued using the Latin alphabet, due to Italian cataloguing rules. However, the library catalogue

(https://unimi.primo.exlibrisgroup.com/discovery/search?vid=39UML_INST:VU1&lang=en) now offers users the possibility to search for foreign books using the original script. Therefore, the library needs to revise the bibliographic records of all Greek books, adding the title, the author(s) and main responsibilities in the original Greek alphabet.

How long: 2 months When: to be defined

Working hours: Monday to Friday, 5 hours a day maximum

Activities:

the candidate will be asked to revise the bibliographic records of Greek books held in the Library, and more specifically:

- to fill in UNIMARC bibliographic 332 field with the bibliographic description in the original Greek writing, using ILS Ex-Libris Alma;
- to fill in UNIMARC bibliographic 676 field (Dewey Decimal Classification, 23° ed., notation [DDC]), using WebDewey software;
- to check the transliteration of bibliographic records, according to the Italian cataloguing rules REICAT;
- to print and paste book labels, if needed.

What to learn:

- cataloguing rules using UNIMARC;
- transliteration rules using REICAT;





- documents semantic analysis;
- indexing using DDC, 23. ed.;
- WebDewey software;
- Alma metadata editor;
- Lipstick software to print labels.

It would be appreciated if the candidate had taken Greek literature courses (ancient and/or modern) as part of his/her university curriculum.
